Kent Night Cup (KNC Event 3)

Venue :	The Hucking Estate is woodland and farmland owned by the Woodland Trust. It is a mixture of open pasture, historic woodland and newer woodland planted over the last ten years. There is an extensive path network.
Map :	1:10,000 scale with 5m contours. Map updated autumn 2018 by N. Speers.
Directions :	<p>Access is easiest either from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The A249 between the M2 and M20. Turn south, first junction straight on and second junction left along narrow country lanes. • From the crossroads north of Hollingbourne Hill, Hollingbourne. Turn west and then two left turns along narrow country lanes. <p>Check out the country lane route on a map before leaving home, or use a SatNav. Public transport: A long way from anywhere! Contact the organiser at least a few days before the event if you need a lift from a local station.</p>
Car Parking :	Parking is at the Hook and Hatchet Pub, Church Road, Hucking ME17 1QT. Please use the overflow car park through the gate and leave the tarmac car park for the other users. Thanks. Grid Ref TQ 837582
Registration :	In the car park between 18:45hrs and 19.15hrs.
Courses :	<p>Suitable for all abilities. Mass start 19.30hrs. 60 minute score event. Twenty one controls in total made up of two sets of ten controls, plus a change over control. Visit as many controls in the set of ten in any order, before visiting the change over control and switching to the second set. Each control is worth 1 point. Course closes 20.30hrs. A penalty of 1 point will be deducted for each minute or part minute you are late back.</p> <p>The competition area does not involve any road crossings. Equipment: SPORTIDENT timing will be used. If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.</p>
Fees :	BOF Seniors £4, Non BOF Seniors £6 (including dibber hire) and Juniors £3. Groups on a single entry appropriate senior rate + £1 per extra person.
Starts :	19.30hrs There is a short walk to the start and so we will be leaving registration at 19:15hrs. Please arrive in good time.
Facilities :	Toilets will be available at the Hook and Hatchet Pub. No muddy shoes please.
Results :	Results will be available at the après-O on the night (see below) and on the DFOK website within a few days.
