



# Dartford West Street Event



**06 December 2018**

**Kent Night Cup - 11**

**Important Note - Insurance advice from British Orienteering.**

*Under 16's may take part in this event non-competitively provided they are accompanied by an adult at all times and the adult assumes full responsibility for them.*

*Note that neither the junior nor the accompanying adult will be eligible for KNC league points.*

<b>Venue :</b>	The streets and paths of west Dartford These are mainly lit but there are some unlit paths and roads (so bring a small head torch, or hand torch).
<b>Map :</b>	1:10,000 scale with 5m contours. New map for 2018.
<b>Directions :</b>	To avoid getting caught in the queue for the Dartford Crossing take the A2 towards London. Leave the A2 at the Wilmington exit for the A2018. Head for Dartford. Cross the roundabout then turn right at the traffic lights (Dartford Tnl A282). Turn left at the next lights (Heath Lane) (P Superstores) to go behind Dunelm Mill. Continue down the hill crossing many sleeping policemen to a roundabout. Turn right onto Highfields Road South and carpark is immediately on your left.
<b>Car Parking :</b>	Parking is adjacent to Highfields Road South near DA1 2JU. Dartford Council are planning to charge for this parking but at time of writing there are no machines. This is a residential area so please be considerate to local residents when parking.
<b>Registration :</b>	At the parking location between 18:45hrs and 19.15hrs.
<b>Courses :</b>	Suitable for all abilities. Mass start 19.30hrs. Collect as many of the twenty one controls as you can (in any order) within the maximum time allowance of 60 minutes. 1 point per control, 1 point will be deducted for each minute or part minute you are late back. Course closes 20.30hrs.
<b>Equipment :</b>	Competitors to wear light coloured clothing, or reflective tops, and have a torch. SPORTIDENT timing will be used. <b>Please bring your dibber to registration as a punched registration system will be used for this event.</b> If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.
<b>Fees :</b>	BOF Seniors £4, Non BOF Seniors £6 (including dibber hire) and Juniors £3. Groups on a single entry appropriate senior rate + £1 per extra person.
<b>Start :</b>	19.30hrs. Please arrive in good time.
<b>Facilities :</b>	<b>There are no toilet facilities in the parking area nor anywhere else in Dartford that I can find.</b> There are a number of pubs in the area but toilets are usually for patrons only. There are toilets at Sainsbury's, Crayford.
<b>Results :</b>	Results will be available at the après-O and on the DFOK website within a few days.
