## Kent Night Cup 8

<b>Venue :</b>	Shorne Woods is a public Country Park owned by Kent County Council. It is a varied mixture of mature woodland, coppice and new growth woodland, with some open areas. The area has an extensive path network. It is partially an old clay pit and has an abundance of earthwork and water features. A great compact area for a KNC event.
<b>Map :</b>	1:7,500 scale with 5m contours. Minor map updates November 2018 by A. Pitcher
<b>Directions :</b>	<p>Eastbound : From the A2 take: The Cobham / Shorne exit and at the Brewers Road T junction at the end of the slip road turn left to go back over the A2 to the roundabout. Take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (signed to Chalk and Thong). Follow this road back over the A2 (for a 2<sup>nd</sup> time) turn right into the Car Park.</p> <p>Westbound : From the A2 take: Take the Cobham/Shorne exit and at the roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit (signed to Chalk and Thong). Follow this road over the A2 and turn right into the Car Park</p> <p>Public transport: The nearest train station is Sole Street (4.1km) on the London to Rochester railway line, or Higham (4.8km) on the North Kent Line.</p>
<b>Car Parking :</b>	<b>New Location from previous KNC events.</b> Parking will be at the Inn on the Lake Hotel, Watling Street, Shorne, Gravesend DA12 3HB.
<b>Registration :</b>	At the parking area between 18.45hrs and 19.15hrs. If you have a dibber please bring it to registration as a dibbed registration system will be used.
<b>Courses :</b>	<p>Suitable for all abilities. Mass start 19.30hrs. Twenty one controls in total, as two sets of ten controls, with a change over control. Collect as many as you can manage in one set before switching to the second set at a change over control. Within each set controls can be taken in any order. Maximum time allowance 60 minutes. Course closes 20.30hrs. Control value 1 point, with 1 point deducted for each minute or part minute you are late back.</p> <p>The competition area does not involve any road crossings.</p> <p>Equipment: SPORTIDENT timing will be used. If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.</p>
<b>Fees :</b>	BOF Seniors £4, Non BOF Seniors £6 (including dibber hire) and Juniors £3. Groups on a single entry appropriate senior rate + £1 per extra person.
<b>Start :</b>	19.30hrs There is a short walk to the start and so we will be leaving registration at 19:20hrs. Please arrive in good time. The Finish will be in a different location involving a 5 min walk alongside the A2.
<b>Facilities :</b>	Toilets in Hotel reception. No muddy shoes please.
<b>Results :</b>	Results will be available at the après-O on the night (see below) and on the DFOK website within a few days.
